What Do I Need to Bring?

1. OLD work clothes (T-shirts, shorts, and work pants) and a good pair of closed-toe work shoes. Remember it will be very hot with possible temperatures in the 100s. Bring enough clothes to last the entire time your group will be staying. Girls: NO exposed sports bras and NO spaghetti straps. Everyone needs shirts with sleeves.
2. Clean, casual clothing to wear after work and after showers!
3. A nice outfit for church Sunday morning. (This is optional. If you are here on Sunday morning, we would love for you to attend church with us.)
4. Shower shoes
5. Work gloves
6. Sleeping bag and pillow
7. Bathing suit; a one-piece for girls (we may be able to arrange swimming)
8. Towels and personal hygiene items
9. Bible and any devotional materials you might use; musicians feel free to bring instruments for worship purposes.
10. Bring some of your favorite snacks to share during your free time in the evenings
11. Spending money. We will have merchandise available for \$15 and under.
12. Work gloves
13. Games to play with your group during free time
14. A big smile and a great attitude!

Financial Information

1. We should already have your \$50.00 non-refundable registration fee reserving your slot.
2. We also should already have your First team deposit of \$250.
3. Upon receiving this packet, your Second deposit of \$250 is due by April 1st.
4. A third deposit is due two weeks before your scheduled date.
5. Please remember you'll need to cover your gas expense as well. Most of the projects require at least a 25 minute drive one way and some as far as 45 minutes one way.

***** CANCELLATION POLICY*****

You may cancel your reservation with ARM up to 6 weeks prior to your scheduled arrival date without penalty. Canceling within 6 weeks or less will result in forfeiting your team deposit (\$500).

Group Equipment

1. Each crew (5-7 people) will need some mode of transportation.
2. Each crew must have a safety/first aid kit on their site.

3. Each person working construction should bring a pair of work gloves and hammer.
4. We have water coolers here, but we encourage you to bringing some extras, especially if you have a group of over 20 people.

Tools (Each crew of 5-7 people need to bring the following)

1. One skill saw and power cord
2. One drill (preferably chargeable)
3. Two tape measures
4. One level and framing square
5. One chalk line
6. If you have a truck and can bring a ladder, please do.
7. One crow bar/pry bar
8. One caulking gun
9. If we know you will be painting, we will have you bring one paintbrush per person

You are always welcome to bring more tools, but these will get you started. (If any of these tools are not available to your group, please let us know. ARM does have some tools; we simply want to ensure that there are enough for all teams to have what they will need.)
