ARM discovers, develops, and deploys spiritual leaders who, as disciples of Jesus Christ, minister with rural and under-resourced communities to create sustainable homes, strengthen families, and build strategic community partnerships for the glory of God.



WHY DOES IT MATTER?

Poverty destroys families and its affects can be found in homes. Many families live in homes that are not warm, safe, and dry. Alabama faces a shortage of nearly 90,000 affordable rental homes. Children are denied access to an educationally enriching, Christ-centered environment during the summer. Rural communities—especially in the Black Belt—face a unique array of economic, social, and political challenges.

The work is demanding and the hours are long, but God will move in your life in powerful ways!

Why do we do it? To end the effects of poverty! By partnering with you we can build more servant leaders, sustainable homes, and strong families for God's glory! We can transform communities!

HOW CAN YOU SERVE?

You could be part of a Christian ministry team of 6-9 college-age men and women hosting middle/high school mission teams during the summer that serve through ARM's home repair and SonShine Kid's day camp in rural Alabama. Each youth mission camp site team is composed of 1 Site Leader, 3-4 Day Camp Counselors, and 3-4 Construction Coordinators. Sites are located in Tuskegee, AL. These are paid positions.

Site Leader

Site leaders manage and direct the summer mission intern and volunteer teams and oversee all operational meals and housing. The ideal site leader has experience serving in leadership roles with their peers and has great organizational skills!

Construction Coordinator

Coordinators are the direct link between the youth teams and the families receiving home repair. Coordinators plan and design the projects and organize the building materials and tools for the youth teams. They ensure timely delivery of materials and help solve problems on the work sites.

Day Camp Counselor

SonShine Kid's Day Camp is a weekly camp running Monday-Thursday. Counselors serve alongside the mission teams to coordinate Bible lessons, recreation, educational enrichment, and more for 25-30 kids ages 6-11. Each week children learn a life-skill module such as financial literacy, nutrition, health, and first aid in addition to the Bible lessons.
