WHO ARE ARM MISSION WEEKS FOR?

ARM's Summer Mission Weeks are uniquely crafted with your church's middle and high school students in mind, focusing on their discipleship and spiritual growth.

While we also host teams of adults, college groups, and intergenerational teams throughout the year, our youth group mission weeks are specifically designed for pre-teens and teens—offering hands-on home repair projects and vibrant children's ministry opportunities.

Your youth will experience a week of Christ-centered growth in many aspects of their lives, including mission servant leadership, and Christian fellowship.



WHY IS THIS OUR MISSION?

At ARM, we are building servant leaders who repair homes and restore community in rural Alabama. Through hands-on service, we respond to the urgent needs of families living in homes that are not safe, warm, or dry.

Inadequate housing can lead to high utility costs, exposure to mold and pests, and serious health risks. In the South, extreme heat and cold can be silent killers, especially for the elderly and young children. At ARM, we believe every person deserves the dignity of a safe, healthy home, and we are committed to making that a reality in rural Alabama. Your youth can be a part of our mission in making homes safe and healthy while extending Jesus's love.

We extend the love of Christ through home repair because we believe poverty housing is contrary to God's desire for His people. Repairing homes is not just about wood, nails, and insulation, it's about restoring hope, dignity, and a sense of belonging.



WHAT IS ARM MISSION WEEK LIKE?

It's a 4-day-5-night (Sunday evening through Friday morning) mission and discipleship experience in rural Alabama. Your team extends the love of Christ with families and kids through home repair and day camp ministries.

Your home repair work can include anything from roof repairs, to painting, or flooring installation for homeowners in desperate need of your service. Some of your team may choose to serve at our day camp, providing VBS-style programming to children 6-12 in Tuskegee through Sonshine Kids Day Camp.

After a full day of service, your team gathers for evening worship, led by our summer ministry team. We provide your meals and housing, coordinate your team's home repair ministry, and serve alongside you with the day camp kids.



A FEW MORE NUTS AND BOLTS

There is a one-time, non-refundable registration fee of \$100 per team, which helps cover administrative costs. This fee is separate from the total team cost. The cost per participant is \$319, which includes all programming, meals, and housing for the week.
