

Communication Specialist

Detailed Ministry Role



The Communication Specialist is part of a Christian ministry team of 6-11 college-age women and men hosting middle/high school mission teams throughout the summer. These youth mission teams serve through ARM's home repair and Sunshine Kids day camp ministries at one of two rural Alabama mission sites. Each youth mission site has a college-aged ministry team composed of 1 Site Leader, 3-4 Sunshine Kids Day Camp Counselors, and 3-4 Construction Coordinators. The mission site is located in Tuskegee, AL (Macon County).

Roles and Responsibilities for All Summer Staff

- Cultivate Christian community with your ministry team
 - Create a safe, clean, friendly, organized, and Christ-centered youth mission experience for middle/high school student mission teams
 - Manage the daily and weekly schedules of youth mission teams
 - Help craft and lead a nightly worship and discipleship experience for our mission teams
- Develop and lead daily morning and lunch devotions with our mission teams
 - Build meaningful relationships with the mission teams as you serve alongside them, encourage them, and model Christian discipleship
 - Help our mission teams prepare meals and maintain our team hosting sites at local churches

Communications Specialist Ministry Role

Each youth mission site staff team has 1 Communication Specialist

You'll visit the home repair sites and day camp capturing all angles of how the mission teams are at work! The Communication Specialist will go out to sites daily and take pictures of Mission Teams and post those to the appropriate folder. You will create and post fun reels and post to social media platforms. The communication specialist will take video footage of students serving in home repair and day camp. They will prepare interview questions for homeowners, set times to record videos, edit videos and post them on arm's website and social media accounts. Each day, take pictures of children at the day camp. Create live reels and fun posts that tell the story of Sunshine Kids Day Camp. Continue to organize pictures and videos in ARMs database. Responsible for end of week and end of summer videos and highlight reels played and posted on ARM's YouTube site.

Time Commitment and Schedule

- 9 1/2 weeks total
 - 2 weeks of training/ 1 Week of set up - schedule set by ARM full-time staff
 - 6 weeks of hosting mission teams/day camp - see Weekly Team Schedule below for details
 - ½ week of site closeout ending with 2 day lake retreat - schedule set by ARM full-time staff
- 15-16 hour days when mission teams are present
- Times of rest on Friday evenings/Saturdays
- Weekly Mission Team Schedule when hosting mission teams

- Sundays, 3pm - youth mission team arrival, afternoon programs, dinner, evening programs
- Monday-Thursday - serving with home repair and Sunshine Kids Day Camp ministries, evening programs each night
- Friday, 9am - youth mission team departure, preparations for following week's team
- Saturday - time of rest
- Daily Mission Team Schedule
 - 7am - Breakfast
 - 7:45am - Devotion
 - 8:30am - Depart for home repair/Sunshine Kids day camp sites
 - 12:00pm - Lunch at home repair/Sunshine Kids day camp sites with lunch devotion
 - 4:00pm - Return from home repair/Sunshine Kids day camp sites
 - 6:00pm - Dinner
 - 7:30pm - Evening Worship/Discussion/Reflection
 - 9:00pm - Free Time
 - 10:00pm - Lights Out, nightly intern team meeting

Compensation

- \$3000 Weekly Stipend/Scholarship at the end of the summer with the option of raising additional scholarship support.

- Mileage reimbursement for ministry-related travel in personal vehicles.
